

ROUTE OVERVIEW

21.1 miles (33.9km

Gentle riverside walking at its finest, taking in a stretch of the Ebor Way and an ancient Roman road, culminating in a stunning aerial view of the city from the top of York Minster tower. Allow plenty of time for the sights of York.

Wetherby to Tadcaster

8.3 miles (13.3km)

- Time 2¹/₂ hours actual walking time
- Total Ascent 90m/295ft
- Map OS Explorer 289 Leeds

The route to York, over gentle, almost flat Yorkshire farmland, follows the Ebor Way, although its white-on-green roundels depicting York Minster are missing at some key points. From Wetherby the route is over farmland until, after **3 miles**, at Thorp Arch, the path follows the banks of the River Wharfe for **5.3 miles** to Tadcaster.

Tadcaster to York

12.8 miles (20.6km)

- Time 4½ hours actual walking time
- Map OS Explorer 290 York


From Tadcaster you take the die-straight route of The Old Street, a Roman road, for **6.2 miles** to Copmanthorpe, then over the fields for **2.2 miles** to Bishopthorpe, where you join a second river, the Ouse, for a **4.4 mile** walk along its banks to the city.

Day walk options

• **By public transport** For the Wetherby to Tadcaster section, take the train to Leeds and a bus or taxi from Leeds station to begin the walk at Wetherby. At Tadcaster take a bus or taxi back to Leeds. For the Tadcaster to York stretch, take the train to York, then a bus or taxi to begin at Tadcaster.

Where to stay or eat along the way

• Tadcaster Stay at the *Shann House Hotel* (a 01937-833931; \sqsubseteq samuelsmithshotels .co.uk/shann-house-hotel-tadcaster) a Georgian townhouse B&B run by the Tadcaster's Sam Smith brewery. **Drink** at the *Angel and White Horse* (a 01937-835470).

• York Numerous places to stay and eat in the city centre.

PILGRIMAGE HIGHLIGHTS

• Admire the 13th century engineering of the stone **bridge** over the River Wharfe at **Wetherby**.

• In York, acknowledge the darker side of faith by visiting three sites associated with religious oppression: The hidden Catholic chapel at the **Bar Convent** (barconvent.org.uk; Mon-Sat 10am-4pm, Sun closed, 17 Blossom Street), the scene of an anti-Semitic atrocity at **Clifford's Tower** (english-heritage.org.uk / visit/places/cliffords-tower-york, Tower St YO1 9SA) and the **shrine of St Margaret Clitherow**, (stwilfridsyork.org.uk / shrine-st-margaret-clitherow; Mon-Sat 9.30am-5pm, Sun 8am-5pm, 35 The Shambles).

Enjoy the awe-inspiring view from the top of **York Minister** (yorkminster.org; Mon-Thur 11am-4:30pm; Fri & Sat 10am-4:30pm; Sun 12.30–2.30pm; Deangate).

| 0 | 0 | SE 40431 48063 | Facing north, with Wetherby Bridge behind you, walk up North St, the B6164 into Wetherby town. |
| 110yds/100m | 110yds/100m | SE 40438 48140 | Turn right into Victoria St. |
| 230yds/210m | 110yds/100m | SE 40583 48104 | At the end of Victoria St turn left into Greenfold Ln. |
| 295yds/270m | 77yds/70m | SE 40601 48120 | At the end of Greenfold Ln turn right into Walton Rd. |
| 770yds/700m | 470yds/430m | SE 40961 47942 | Where Walton Rd meets the junction with the A168 at the roundabout, go straight on, keeping to Walton Rd and walking towards the bridge you can see over the dual carriageways of the A1(M). |
| 880yds/800m | 110yds/100m | SE 41070 47883 SE 41216 47911 | Immediately after crossing the bridge, turn sharp right and descend the bank towards the track that runs parallel with the motorway. <i>Or, if you prefer a gentler descent, continue for 800m where the track meets Walton Rd, and turn right there.</i> |
| 0.6mile/1km | 220yds/200m | SE 40971 47773 | Turn left onto a narrower track between hedges, marked with a Footpath sign and as Heuthwaite Ln on OS maps. |
| 0.7mile/1.1km | 110yds/100m | SE 41116 47706 | Follow the track as it turns right. |
| 0.8mile/1.2km | 110yds/100m | SE 41085 47623 | Follow the track as it turns left, until it meets tarmacked Watersole Ln. |
| 1.1mile/1.7km | 550yds/500m | SE 41540 47346 | Where Heuthwaite Ln meets Watersole Ln cross over and continue straight on along a path on the field margin. OS maps show a right of way angling 20 degrees left to cross this field, then turning right at the far field margin, but this route is not evident on the ground. |

| 1.4miles/2.2km | 550yds/500m | SE 41983 47405 | Reaching the far side of this field, bear slight right to follow the path alongside trees. |

| 1.5miles/2.5km | 330yds/300m | SE 42273 47385 | Keep straight ahead as the path joins Flintmill Ln, and pass Flint Mill Grange, keeping the farm buildings to your right and continuing along Flintmill Ln. |
| 1.8miles/2.9km | 440yds/400m | SE 42466 47353 | As the tarmacked lane turns right, continue straight ahead on the track and follow it round to the right, along a field boundary towards woodland. |
| 1.9miles/3km | 110yds/100m | SE 42678 47182 | The track then bears slight left through woodland, up to a left-hand bend between fields. |
| 2.2miles/3.5km | 550yds/500m | SE 42986 46887 | Follow the path round to the left and along to meet Wood Ln. |
| 2.3miles/3.7km | 220yds/200m | SE 43218 46913 | At the T-junction, turn right onto Wood Ln. There is a rare Ebor Way fingerboard at this point. Continue along the lane to the village of Thorp Arch. |
| 2.7miles/4.4km | 770yds/700m | SE 43269 46258 | Reach the village of Thorp Arch, and continue straight on, along what is now a lane called The Village, and through a staggered crossroads, with Thorp Arch Pk to your right, then Dowkell Ln to your left. |
| 2.9miles/4.7km | 330yds/300m | SE 43307 45932 | Continue straight on, the lane now becoming Bridge Foot. |
| 3.1miles/5km | 330yds/300m | SE 43150 45701 | Cross the River Wharfe via the bridge and then turn immediately left, following a tarmacked track that slopes down to the riverbank. Continue along the riverbank path, with the river on your left. |
| 3.3miles/5.4km | 440yds/400m | | Pass the former Spa Baths buildings (on your left) and hotel (Wharfdale Hall, on your right) at Town Ings. |
| 3.7miles/6km | 660yds/600m | SE 44177 45225 | As you leave the built-up area, keep to the riverbank, following a path which, apart from one slight divergence away from the river where a footbridge takes you over Firgreen Beck, hugs the bank. |
| 4.3miles/7km | 330yds/300m | SE 44692 45374 | Pass beneath Wharfe Bridge, keeping to the riverbank path. |
| 4.6miles/7.5km | 550yds/500m | SE 45185 45575 | Bear right away from the riverbank to join a track, with the tree-lined field margin to your left, and continue along it as it kinks left and continues between hedges. |

| 5.3miles/8.5km | 0.6mile/1km | SE 45466 | Where the track meets the A659 turn left and walk along the pavement to the next |

| 5.5miles/8.9km | 440yds/400m | SE 45887 44558 | Turn left into Croft Ln, and follow it to the hamlet of Newton Kyme. |
| 5.9miles/9.6km | 770yds/700m | SE 46393 44874 | Continue straight on through a junction where, confusingly, your route ahead and the turning to the right are both called Croft Ln. Continue straight on for 100m towards Newton Kyme Hall. |
| 6miles/9.7km | 110yds/100m | SE 46458 44882 SE 46924 44887 | Leave Croft Ln by the path that first arcs right, then bears left, to pass Newton Kyme Hall and St Andrew's church. Bear gently left after these and pass just to the left of a belt of woodland to join the riverbank path . This riverbank path will take you, following the River Wharfe's many twists and turns, all the way to Tadcaster. |
| 7.9miles/12.7km | 1.9miles/3km | SE 48436 43842 | Pass beneath Tadcaster Viaduct, and then pass Tadcaster Weir, keeping to the riverbank. |
| 8miles/13km | 330yds/300m | SE 48585 43552 SE 48569 43439 | Reaching St Mary's Church, Tadcaster, bear left to leave the riverbank and enter the churchyard. Continue through the churchyard to reach a lane called Churchyard, and turn left , joining Kirkgate, the A659. |
| 8.2miles/13.2km | 220yds/200m | | The Ark, the timber framed house across the road on your right, is reputedly the place where the Pilgrim Fathers planned their trip to America. Continue along Kirkgate to the High St. |
| 8.3miles/13.3km | 110yds/100m | SE 48640 43336 | Turn left into High St. You are now in the centre of Tadcaster. |

| 8.3miles/13.3km | 0 | | To continue, follow the High St (A659) through Tadcaster. It becomes York Rd |
| 9.2miles/14.8km | 0.9miles/1.5km | SE 49862 44075 | Where the A659 joins the A64, keep to the pavement, with the junction to your right, for a short stretch alongside this busy road. Continue past the large industrial estate on the left. |

| 9.6miles/15.5km | 770yds/700m | SE 50591 | Turn left, away from the main road, up Catterton Ln. Follow this as it bears right and |

| 11.9miles/19.1km | 990yds/900m | SE 53555 45984 SE 53624 46086 | At the exit for services, follow the blue Ebor Way fingerpost that directs you up steps to a road passing above the main carriageway. Turn right to follow this road over the A64 as it bends to the right and descends on the other side. Before it reaches the junction, look out for another blue Ebor Way finger post pointing left. |
| 12.2miles/19.6km | 550yds/500m | SE 53743 45853 SE 54806 46253 | Turn left to take the Ebor Way into a field. Walk along the left-hand field margin, with the embankment of the road you have just left on your right. You are again on the course of The Old Street. Where it meets a lane continue straight ahead towards Copmanthorpe. |
| 13.9miles/22.4km | 1.7miles/2.8km | SE 56176 47140 | Reaching the outskirts of the village of Copmanthorpe, where the path meets a lane called Manor Heath, turn right on to Manor Heath and cross over. |
| 14miles/22.6km | 220yds/200m | SE 56244 46910 | When Manor Heath bends left, and becomes School Ln, continue along until it meets Horseman Ln. |
| 14.1miles/22.8km | 220yds/200m | SE 56449 46934 | Bear right onto Horseman Ln and continue to first turning on left, Church St. |
| 14.2miles/22.9km | 110yds/100m | SE 56484 46903 | Bear left onto Church St and continue to junction with Low Green. |
| 14.3miles/23km | 110yds/100m | SE 56553 46906 | Turn left onto Low Green for 100m. |

| 14.4miles/23.1km | 110yds/100m | SE 56628 46956 | Turn right off Low Green onto an unsignposted footpath leading between houses, past a school and along two sides of its playing fields, to emerge in Wheelwright Close. |

| 14.6miles/23.6km | 220yds/200m | SE 57046 47122 | Turn right into Fletchers Croft and walk towards the railway line. |
| 14.7miles/23.7km | 110yds/100m | SE 57084 47107 SE 57122 47151 | At the foot of Fletchers Croft, before the railway line, turn left to take a path leading alongside the railway. Turn right to cross the railway. CAUTION: There is a light to signal when it is safe to cross. Cross only on green . Continue over fields, keeping to the right-hand field margin, with a hedge to your right. |
| 15.2miles/24.4km | 770yds/700m | SE 57766 47292 | Follow the path as it kinks left, then right to take a footbridge over a stream. Continue straight ahead along the field boundary until you approach some houses and the path bends round to the right, then left and meets Copmanthorpe Ln. |
| 15.5miles/25km | 660yds/600m | SE 58388 47462 | Turn right into Copmanthorpe Ln. Follow the lane towards Bishopthorpe village, until it reaches Bridge Rd on the right. |
| 15.8miles/25.5km | 550yds/500m | SE 58804 47490 | Turn right into Bridge Rd and continue to the end. |
| 16miles/25.8km | 330yds/300m | SE 58934 47262 | Where Bridge Rd meets Appleton Rd, turn left into Appleton Rd. |
| 16.3miles/26.2km | 440yds/400m | SE 59175 47586 | Continue along as Appleton Rd bears slight right and becomes Main St. |
| 16.5miles/26.6km | 440yds/400m | SE 59596 47719 | Where Main St meets Bishopthorpe Rd, bear left and follow Bishopthorpe Rd. Bishopthorpe Palace, residence of the Archbishop of York, is almost immediately on your right. Keep going along Bishopthorpe Rd. |
