PRACTICAL INFORMATION

ROUTE OVERVIEW

15.9 miles (25.6km)

Options to divide this stage are limited. At around 5.5 miles (8.8km) in on today's 15.9 mile stage, Litcham is nowhere near half way, but it does have an inn and a grocery, so is a good place to stock up. Tittleshall is at the half-way point, but has no facilities. See below for taxis covering the route.

From Castle Acre the route follows the Nar Valley Way on a level path close to the river, before a short gentle climb up a lane to East Lexham, reached in 3.7 miles. Quiet roads take you on to Litcham, in 1.9 miles, the most substantial village on the stage. It is 2.9 miles more on level lanes to Tittleshall, the half-way point.

Whissonsett is a further **2.4 miles**, mainly on footpaths, and it is **2.5 miles** more to Colkirk, once again on quiet lanes. Fakenham is reached in another **2.5 miles**.

Public transport options

Again, you are deep in the countryside here. Other than the infrequent No 32 community **bus** between Castle Acre and Litcham, the only viable transport option on this stage is a **taxi**. Among operators are *Tiny's Taxis* (**a** 01328-888888, **www.tinys.org.uk**) and *Jak's Taxis* (**a** 01328-887488, **b** jaktaxis.co.uk), both based in Fakenham. See also pp29-31.

- **Litcham** (after 5.5 miles, 8.8km) **Stay** and **eat** at *Bull Inn* (☎ 01328-701340; check with pub for current opening and food hours; 1 Church St), a village inn with rooms.
- Godwick (after 9.6 miles 15.4km) *Godwick Hall* (☎ 01328-701948, 🗏 godwick hall.co.uk, Mill Lane; 2 nights minimum) is a possible accommodation point if you are prepared to splash out on one of its three swanky shepherds huts.
- Fakenham Accommodation options include *Wensum Lodge Hotel* (☎ 01328-862100, ☐ wensumlodge.co.uk; Bridge St; 17 en-suite rooms) by the river and part of a former mill dating from 1750; and *Erika's B&B* (☎ 01328 863058, ☐ erikas-bandb.co.uk; 3 Glad-

stone Rd NR21 9BZ) six en-suite rooms in a modern house close to the town centre. For a **meal** head to *The Crown* (☎ 01328-855278, ☐ facebook .com & search The Crown Fakenham; 6 Market Pl; open Mon-Sat 10am-late, Sun from 11am, food Mon-Wed noon-2pm, Thur-Sat noon-2pm & 6-9pm, Sun carvery noon-3pm), a friendly, 15th-century local and former pilgrim hostelry.



27 Feb 2023		Updates were made to the downloadable walking instructions, gpx and kml files as follows:
		Newton Mill : At Newton Mill, at the 1.2mile point, a temporary diversion is in place, taking the Nar Valley Way further down the lane before turning left to shadow the original route, rejoining it at the 1.9mile point.
		Colkirk : at the 13 mile point there is an amended route through the village of Colkirk, followed by a new route to Hempton Green, on the outskirts of Fakenham, rejoining the original route at the 15.5mile point.

1mile/1.6km	550yds/500m	Ford the stream and continue straight on until you reach a lane.
1.2miles/2km	440yds/400m	When the path reaches a lane, a little before Newton Mill, bear right onto it, passing Newton Mill. NOTE: There is currently a diversion at Newton Mill, but it may be removed at short notice.

		If the diversion is in place, continue along the lane past Newton Mill for 100yds. Look out for a
		Nar Valley way fingerpost pointing left off the lane.
		If the diversion is not in place, turn sharp left along the path immediately alongside Newton Mill,
		with the buildings on your left. There should be a fingerpost with a Nar valley way roundel on it
		pointing in this direction.
1.6miles/2.6km	660yds/600m	This direction apples while the diversion is in place.
		Turn left, as indicated by the Nar Valley fingerpost and a hand-made wooden sign reading 'Nar
		Valley Way Temporary Diversion'. Immediately after turning onto this path, you come to an
		unsignposted Y junction. Take the right-hand fork of the Y. Continue, skirting the pits on your left,
		until you reach a track.

		for Priory Farm on your right, just before the river.
6miles/9.6km	220yds/200m	Arrive at Priory Farm, which was Litcham Priory .
		To continue, retrace your steps up Church St, looking out for Druids Ln on your right

		B1145.
6.3miles/10.2km	440yds/400m	Cross straight over the B1145 and continue along Back Ln.
6.4miles/10.3km	110yds/100m	Continue straight on where Back Ln joins Tittleshall Rd, which becomes Litcham Rd.
7.8miles/12.6km	1.4miles/2.2k	At a junction, where a lane joins from the right and a footpath from the left, continue straight on along Litcham Rd.
8.1miles/13.1km	550yds/500m	At a staggered junction, with Mileham Rd joining from the right and Heath Ln slightly later from

8.8miles/14.1km	110yds/100m	At the T junction on the outskirts of Tittleshall, where Church Ln joins Fakenham Rd, turn right onto a footpath, marked with a fingerpost. The Ordnance Survey shows a right of way running
		diagonally left across this field, and the path is often marked through the crop by the farmer.
		If there is no clear diagonal path, or it is very muddy, you might prefer to follow the field margin.
		If you do, turn left at the foot of the field until, in the next corner, you see a stile to your right.
		If you use the diagonal option, the path will lead straight to the stile on the far side of the field.
		The following distance points relate to walkers using the latter.
9.2miles/14.8km	770yds/700m	Go right over the stile. In the next field, the OS shows a path running diagonally across. However,
	J	this is not evident on the ground. The field margin is well walked, despite a sign saying the
		Permissive Path here is no longer operational. Walk the margin on your right then, after turning left
		at the corner of the field, look out for a stile about half way along this margin.
9.5miles/15.3km	550yds/500m	Climb the stile into the next field, and Godwick's ruined church tower comes up on your right.
9.6miles/15.4km	110yds/100m	Arrive at Godwick's interpretation board
9.7miles/15.7km	330yds/300m	Leave the village site, crossing over the stile and through a succession of fields.

10.5miles/17km	.8mile/1.3km	Where the footpath meets a farm track on the outskirts of Whissonsett, turn left onto it. Then, after
		30yds, take the footpath on your right, leading diagonally across a field to Mill Ln, and the village.
10.7miles/17.3km	330yds/300m	When the path joins Mill Ln, turn right onto it, passing London Rd on your left, until you reach the
		churchyard of St Mary's, also on your left.
10.9miles/17.5km	220yds/200m	Arrive at St Mary's , Whissonset.
		To continue, retrace your steps and turn right into London St.
11.3miles/18.2km	770yds/700m	Where New Rd joins from the right, bear left to follow the lane you are on, which is now named
		Colkirk Rd. Continue until a T-junction, where Oxwick Rd runs right to left.
11.8miles/19km	880yds/800m	Turn left into Oxwick Rd. This becomes Whissonsett Rd.
12.2miles/19.6km	660yds/600m	Where Whissonsett Rd bears right at the T-junction of lanes before Manor Farm, bear right to
		remain on it towards the village of Colkirk.
13miles/21km	.8mile/1.4km	At the staggered T-junction in Colkirk, turn left onto School Rd, then right onto Gormans Ln until
		it reaches Church Rd. You will see St Mary's on the far side of Church Rd.
13.1miles/21.1km	110yds/100m	Arrive at St Mary's , Colkirk. To continue, return to Church Rd and turn right onto it. The lane
		becomes a byway, with a fingerpost reading 'Restricted Byway' after you pass its junction with
		Gormans Ln.
13.8miles/22.3km	330yds/300m	Continue along the byway as it bears slight right.
14miles/22.5km	330yds/300m	Continue along the byway as it bears left, a less distinct track branching off to the right, until, at a
		T-junction, you reach a lane.
14.1miles/22.7km	220yds/200m	Turn right on to the lane. There are wide verges on either side, but the one on the right-hand side is
		best. Continue until you reach the A1065.
15miles/24.1km	.9mile/1.4km	Turn right onto the A1065, following the pavement on the right-hand side, until you reach
		Hempton Rd.
15.1miles/24.3km	220yds/200m	Turn right to follow Hempton Rd across Hempton Green, continuing straight on over a crossroads,
		until you reach Dereham Rd, B1146.
15.6miles/25.2km	.5mile/900m	Turn right onto Dereham Rd, B1146
15.9miles/25.6km	440yds/400m	Cross the River Wensum.

16miles/25.7km	110yds/100m	At the mini-roundabout, go straight on into Bridge St.
16.1miles/25.9km	220yds/200m	When Bridge St meets Market Pl at a T-junction, turn left. Look out for the church of St Peter and St Paul, the tower of which appears over the rooftops to your right.
16.2miles/26km	220yds/200m	Arrive at the church of St Peter and St Paul , where this stage ends.
