

		Stage 14: Walsingham to Wells-next-the-Sea
Distance from start	Distance from last waypoint	
0miles/0km	0miles/0km	The stage commences in Common Place, Little Walsingham. Buses from Kings Lynn and Fakenham [service 36 Coastliner] stop in Common Place. Take Bridewell Street, which is to the left of the Shrine giftshop. Continue until you reach Guild St.
200yds/180m	200yds/180m	Turn right into Guild St and walk to the junction with Knight St.
300yds/270m	100yds/90m	Turn left into Knight St, which becomes Wells Rd and continue until you reach St Peter's Rd, a turning on your right.
600yds/550m	300yds/280m	Turn right into St Peter's Rd and look out for St Peter's church, on your left.
1,000yds/ 900m	400yds/350m	Arrive at St Peter's church. To continue, rejoin St Peter's Rd and turn left to follow it. Look out for a wayside cross on a triangle of green to the left of the lane.
1,230yds/ 1.1km	230yds/200m	Arrive at the wayside cross. Continue along St Peter's Rd, which becomes Westgate, and continue until you reach a T junction, with Scarborough Rd crossing left to right in front of you, and the Orthodox Church of the Holy Transfiguration over the road.
1mile/1.6km	550yds/500m	Arrive at the Orthodox Church of the Holy Transfiguration. To continue, turn right out of the church and take Scarborough Rd. Continue along Scarborough Rd until you reach a junction.
1.1mile/1.8km	220yds/200m	At the junction where Scarborough Rd goes straight on, take the lane to your left, signposted Wighton and Wells. Continue until, just before Whey Curd Farm.
2miles/3.2km	.9miles/1.4km	On the far side of the field to your left is the site of a former pilgrim chapel is marked on the OS Explorer map. Continue along the lane until you reach a junction at Copy's Green.
2.3miles/3.7km	550yds/500m	At the Copy's Green junction, bear left (signposted Wells) to follow the lane (now called High St) into Wighton. look out for the Carpenters Arms, to your right.
2.5miles/4km	330yds/300m	Arrive at the Carpenter's Arms. [www.carpentersarmsnorfolk.co.uk] Just beyond it, to the left of the lane, is the Methodist Heritage Centre. Group visits can be arranged on request: 07546-732092 or eamethodistheritage@gmail.com

		Continue along High St, looking out for All Saints, Wighton, which is reached by turning right up Kirkgate Ln.
2.7miles/4.3km	330yds/300m	Arrive at All Saints Wighton. To continue, rejoin High St and turn right. Look out for a track leaving the lane to your left. At the entrance to the track are signs reading 'Campsite open all year' and 'Potters Farm'.
3miles/4.8km	550yds/500m	Turn left onto the track. Continue as the lane enters Gallows Hill Wood and reaches a crossroads of tracks at Gallow Hill.
4.6miles/7.4km	1.6miles/ 2.6km	At Gallow Hill, cross the track (Gallow Hill Rd) that runs left to right, and take Market Ln, the track on the far side of the junction, which leads downhill towards Wells. A blue fingerpost points to Wells and Holkham Circuit. Continue until the way becomes tarmacked and there is a school (Alderman Peel High School) to your right.
5.5miles/8.8km	.9mile/1.4km	At the school, continue straight on along Market Ln. Walk until you reach a junction with Burnt St.
5.7miles/9.2km	440yds/400m	Turn left into Burnt St and then almost immediately right into Plummers Hill. Continue until you reach The Buttlands.
5.8miles/9.3km	220yds/200m	Bear left into The Buttlands, keeping the green to your right, until you reach a junction with Station Rd.
5.9miles/9.5km	220yds/200m	Turn right into Station Rd, where there is a bus stop for Coastliner 36 buses towards Walsingham and Fakenham. Turn almost immediately left into Newgate Ln. Continue along Newgate Ln, which becomes Jickling Yard, until you reach The Quay.
6.1miles/9.3km	220yds/200m	This stage of the walk ends at The Quay. For Coastliner 36 services towards King's Lynn, turn left on The Quay and walk along the B1105 to the Ark Royal pub, where there is a bus stop.
